CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

On April 19, 2025, Almaty Management University (AlmaU) will host the *ICTH 2025 – “*Tolyq Adam*”: *Transforming The Content of Education*” dedicated to the 180th anniversary of Abai Qunanbaiuly.

This conference aims to create a platform for dialogue between international and domestic scholars on innovative educational experiences and transformational ideas. It will also consider integrating Abai Qunanbaiuly’s “Tolyq Adam” (Holistic Human) concept into Kazakhstan’s national education concept.

The main directions of the conference:

1. From Knowledge to Creativity: The Socio-Philosophical Aspects of the 21st-Century Individual (philosophy, sociology, political science, life design);
2. “Service Learning”: Best Practices and Prospects;
3. Qazaq tili 2.0: Digital Era and New Approaches to Teaching;
4. Biohacking: The Science of Human Potential and Sustainable Societies (physical culture);
5. Language Learning Today: Trends and Challenges (English, French, Turkish, Korean, Chinese and methodology of teaching foreign languages).

- Abstracts submitted after March 25, 2025, or those not meeting the requirements will not be accepted;
- Accepted abstracts will be notified by March 30;
- The author is responsible for the content and accuracy of the materials.
- A 72-hour certificate of participation will be awarded to all participants with accepted abstracts,
- Certificate of Attendance will be awarded to all participants.
- A participation fee of 10,000 KZT /20 USD will be charged after the abstract acceptance;
- Travel and accommodation expenses are to be covered by the participants.

Submission Requirements:

- Abstracts should be between 300 and 500 words, and the document should be in Microsoft Word format.
- Font requirement: Times New Roman, size 12, 1.5 lined space
- Please include 5-6 keywords at the end of the abstract.

Abstract Presentation

A single author or a group of authors will deliver a paper presentation lasting approximately 15 minutes within a 90-minute session. All submitted proposals will undergo a peer review process. Paper presentation proposals should be between 300 and 500 words and must include the following elements, even if the findings are still preliminary at the time of submission:

- Objectives or goals of the study
- Primary theoretical or conceptual framework
- Research design, analytical methods, or inquiry approach
- Sources of data or supporting evidence
- Findings and/or conclusions
- Study's significance and contributions

Poster - presentation

An individual author or a team of authors will showcase a poster (90 cm wide and 120 cm tall) at the congress venue. All submitted proposals will undergo a peer review process. Poster proposals should be between 300 and 500 words and must include the following details, even if the findings are still preliminary at the time of submission:

- Study objectives or purpose
- Primary theoretical or conceptual framework
- Research design, analytical methods, or approach to inquiry
- Data sources or supporting evidence
- Findings and/or conclusions
- Significance and contribution of the study

Workshop

An instructor or a team of instructors will conduct hands-on training to help a targeted audience achieve specific professional objectives within a defined timeframe. Each workshop proposal must include the following details:

- A 500-word summary outlining the workshop's objectives, target audience, instructional goals, and planned activities.
- A list of instructors, including their names and institutional affiliations.
- A specification of equipment or room setup requirements.
- The proposed duration of the workshop (minimum of 90 minutes or in increments of 90 minutes, with appropriate breaks).
